Sindy and Charvin met each other in Roatán. They've been married for about 11 years. They have 4 beautiful boys. David is 11 years old; he is in 4th grade. Arvin is 9 years old; he is in 3rd grade. Junior is 6 years old; he is in 1st grade. Eleazar is 3 years old. Sindy is 29 years old. She moved to Roatan 11 years ago. Sindy grew in the mainland Honduras in a very remote area. She didn't have the opportunity to finish her studies because she had to walk a very long distance to attend to school. She was able to attend only up to 2nd grade. Sindy grew up with her mom and 3 siblings. They were abandoned by their dad when they were very little. Sindy's mom worked washing and ironing clothes for her friends, that was the only income they were able to get to

support their family. Sindy decided to move to Roatán to look for a job and a better life. She started working as a housekeeper at a hotel. Later on, she started working in other jobs such as: in a convenience store, a cook and as a babysitter as well. Currently, Sindy stays at home taking care of her children. Charvin moved to Roatan 14 years ago; he is 34 years old. Charvin lived in a less remote area in the mainland Honduras; he was able to finish his 6th grade. Charvin never met his dad. He grew up with his mom and his 3 siblings, Charvin is the oldest child. Charvin's mom worked for somebody else at a small dining place cooking, mainly making tortillas. Charvin started working at a very young age so he could help his mom bring a little bit of more income to feed and support his family. He started working at a farm milking cows; he did it for about 5 years. Later on, he started working for his uncle at a carpentry shop. Charvin decided to move to Roatan to look for a better job and a better life as well. Charvin met a Pastor who gave him the opportunity to work as a security guard at night taking care of the church storage room and he worked as a gardener and cleaning different lots for the Pastor's friends. Currently, Charvin works as a welder at a shipping boat shop. He's been working at this job for around 8 years. Charvin makes around \$16 per day. Sindy and Charvin work as hard as they can to feed and support their family. They dream of giving their children a better and more stable life than the one they had growing up. They dream to someday build a strong, dry and comfortable place for their family to live in. Let's be part of their dream. Let's build a home for this beautiful family!
